Cincinnati

Students will explore and gain a deeper understanding of their own city while working with kids, repairing homes and serving the homeless.

Cleveland

Each day students will gain a bigger perspective of challenges of urban life while working directly with the local community, refugees and the marginalized.

Rockcastle County, KY

The service activities will focus mainly on housing repair and construction and students will learn more about the challenges of rural poverty.

Toppa Joppa Mountain, TN

While helping communities in the mountains with housing repairs, students will discover the challenges that immigrants face in rural America.

West Virginia

After working to provide agricultural produce for the underserved, students will explore the state and better understand life in coal country.
