The Religion Dept. of St. Xavier High School is comprised of 15 faculty members, full and part-time. The philosophy and approach of the department is to:

- Invite students to a deeper understanding of our relationship with God who became incarnate in Jesus Christ through study of both the Hebrew and Christian Scriptures
- Encourage students to experience God as present in his own life and the sacramental life of the Church
- Equip students with a systematic approach to forming conscience and confronting personal and social moral problems
- Explore various dimensions that are involved in living as disciples in the modern world

Each student is required to take eight semesters of religion throughout their high school career. Their regimen will run as follows:

- Freshmen: Scriptures: Old and New Testament
- **Sophomores**: Faith, Church, and Sacraments
- Juniors: Christian Morality/Social Justice
- <u>Seniors</u>: A choice of two of the following electives:
