The Doyle Foundation Matching Gift Program has been established to raise awareness about the vital importance of building the scholarship endowment at St. Xavier High School by recognizing those who establish new endowed scholarship funds or expand existing ones at St. X.

Key Components of the Program

- An individual makes an initial gift of \$10,000 or more to establish or expand an endowed scholarship fund, plus agrees to make additional gifts of \$10,000 or more to the fund in each of the following three years (totaling at least \$40,000.)
- The benefactor also agrees to become a member of the Father Edward Wieber SJ Society and establish a legacy gift for St. Xavier in their estate of at least \$50,000. This amount, when eventually received by the

school, will also be added to the benefactor's endowed scholarship fund.

- Upon receipt of the initial installment and simple documentation of a planned gift to St. Xavier, the Doyle Foundation contributes an additional \$10,000 to the individual's scholarship fund.
- Donors are matched with a particular student receiving aid equivalent to their gift, and are invited to meet their student at a reception in the fall.
